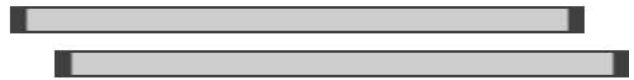
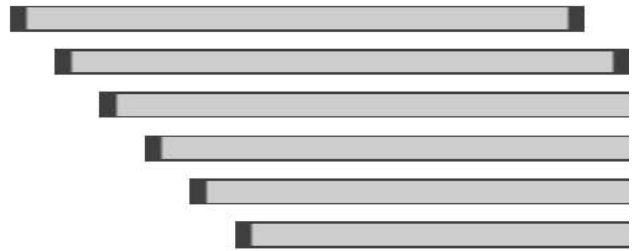
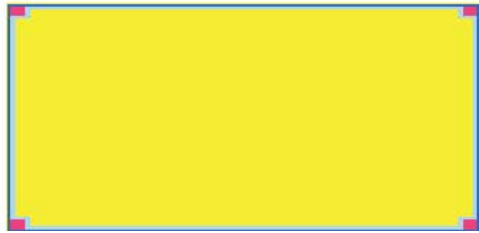


SYSTEMATIC SEQUENTIAL PHONICAS TILE FOLDER

MATERIALS:

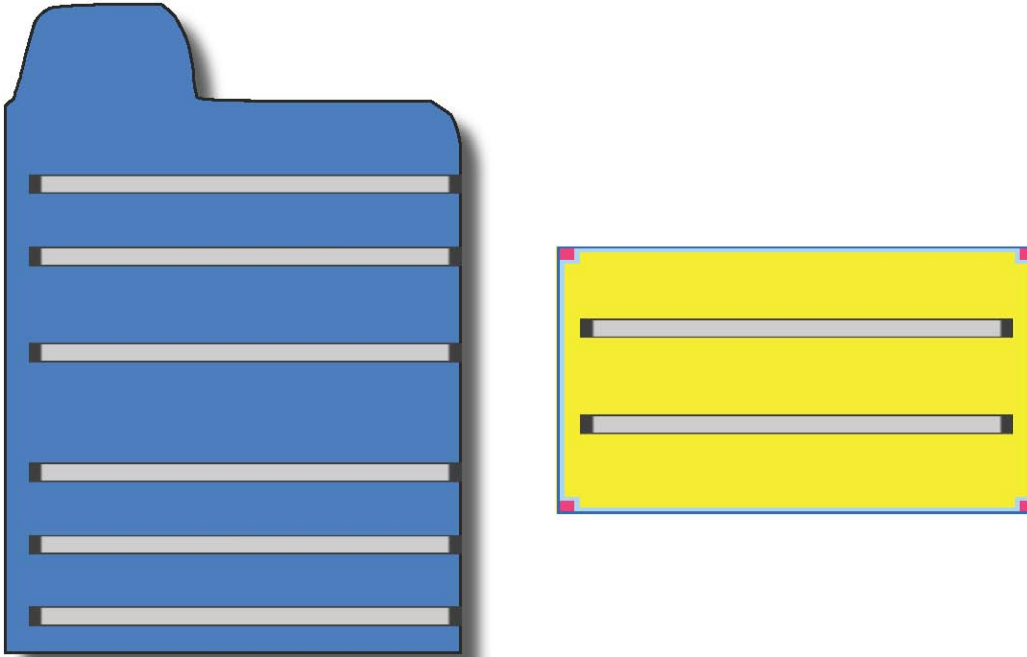
- 1 legal folder - laminated
- 1 cut piece of file folder - laminated
- 6 long pieces of Velcro - soft
- 2 shorter pieces of Velcro - soft
- Approximately 60 small pieces of rough Velcro
- Laminated ABC pages with upper and lower case letters

DIRECTIONS:

1. Place six pieces of soft Velcro lengthwise along the top and bottom half of the inside of the laminated folder, separating each piece by at least an inch.



2. Attach 2 pieces of soft Velcro lengthwise on the cut piece of file folder, separating each piece by at least one and one-half inches.

3. Attach rough Velcro dots to the back of each letter. DO NOT CUT OUT LETTERS UNTIL YOU PLACE VELCRO DOTS ON THEM.

Cut out the letters and place in the folder as directed below.

Place the lower case letters alphabetically on the inside bottom of the file folder.

Place the upper case letters alphabetically on the inside top of the file folder.

Use the letter file folder as a workspace for the student. If the entire alphabet is too many letters for the student to use, choose those that are appropriate for each activity.
